**Evening:** Celtic Challenge No.3.

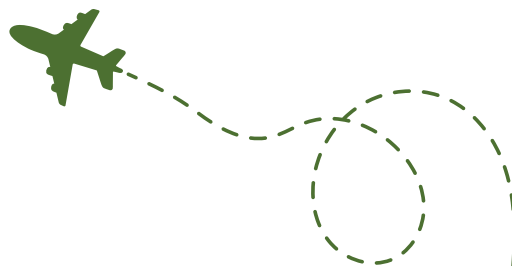
### DAY 6
